

Baroda Township Board  
Budget Workshop  
Monday January, 30, 2017

The Baroda Township Board met at 6:30 On Monday January 30, 2017 to begin the process of working on the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Budget. Present were Jim Brow, Brenda Troxell, David Wolf, Wendie Shafer and Fire Chief Larry Klug.

There was much discussion regarding the Fire Maintenance and Fire Equipment funds. It was determined that Several purchases from the Fire Maintenance fund were identified as capital expense Items that could have been paid for from the Fire Equipment fund. The Clerk is to reimburse the Fire Maint. fund from the Fire EQ fund for those purchases. Several Line items were proposed for the Fire Maintenance Budget. Firefighter pay raises was discussed.

It was requested that a Year to Date column be added to the work budget file. Wendie is to add the column and send altered file to Board members.

David Wolf moved supported by Brenda Troxell to purchase a battery operated Combination Cutter-Spreader extrication tool, 6 VHF-Motorola Pagers, and Plastic Cribbing (Step Chocks), K-12 circular Saw, FireCom & Radio Headsets for 222 and an industrial washing machine totaling up to \$25,136.62. After discussion, Vote- All Yes M.C.

Wendie Shafer Moved supported by David Wolf to approve expending up to \$2500 to Wightman and Assoc. to update the Current Township Master Plan. After discussion, Vote – All Yes M.C.

The budget workshop was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
