**STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ORDINANCE FOR FLOODPLAIN
MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS**

The Township of Baroda ordains:

Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Official of the Township of Baroda is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Baroda under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Township of Baroda assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said act through out it corporate limits.

Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by enforcing agency within the Township of Baroda.

Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "Berrien County, Michigan and incorporated areas" and dated April 17, 2006, and Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) Panel Numbers: 26021 0210C, 26021 0220C, 26021 0228C, 26021 0230C, 26021 0240C, dated April 17, 2006 are adopted, by reference and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code.

Section 4. REPEALS. All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5, PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
