Home alarm systems must be registered with the Baroda-Lake Police Department. Please call them at (269)465-3258 to register your information. The annual fee is \$10.

❖ **HOUSING RENTAL ORDINANCE**

**NOTICE:** All Rental Homes and Rental Units within Baroda Township are Required to be Registered, Inspected and have a Certificate of Compliance. The fee for Initial Registration and Inspection is \$150. Additional or follow-up inspection fee is \$30. The Annual Registration Renewal fee is \$50. Biennial (every 2 years) Inspection fee is \$50. ❖ **Rubbish and Garbage Pick Up**

Trash containers should be at the road by 5:00am on Thursday morning. During holiday weeks, the garbage should still be out by 5:00am Thursday, but may not be picked up until the next day.

❖ **Curbside Recycling**

Curbside recycling is available for recyclable materials as well as yard waste. Yellow recycling bags are available at no cost and can be picked up at the Township office. Green yard waste bags may be purchased for \$1.00 each at the Township office. The cost covers the fee to dispose of the yard waste.

❖ **Large Trash Pick Up**

Fall large trash pickup will be done October 11, 2018. No deep freezers, air conditioners, or other appliances containing Freon gas will be picked up unless there is a certificate attached to indicate that the appliance is Freon free. No leaves, tree limbs, tires, large car parts or building materials will be picked up. The limit is ¾ ton pick-up load per household.

The hall may be reserved by Baroda Township and Baroda Village residents only. The Hall is available for private parties, subject to board approval, for a fee of \$35. The Hall is available for non-profit organizations without a fee. Please contact the Township office at 422-2300 to make reservations. (Please note: THIS IS NOT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING.)

❖ **Hess Lake Park**

Beginning January 2, 2019 at 9:00 am, Baroda Township residents may call to make park reservations. After 12:00 pm on January 22<sup>nd</sup>, thru October 31<sup>st</sup>, reservations are open to everyone. Non-profit organizations may reserve the pavilions at no cost.
