A public hearing concerning a request for a Special Land Use for a Horse Stable on property 11-02-0024-0001-00-9 owned Barbara Day will be held by the Baroda Township Planning Commission on Monday October 8, 2018 commencing at 6:30 p.m., at the Baroda Municipal Building, 9091 First St., Baroda Michigan 49101.

Items to be considered are: Request by Barbara and Kelly Day to operate a Horse Stables at 722 W. Shawnee Rd., Baroda MI and such other matters as may properly come before the commission.

The Baroda Township Planning Commission reserves the right to alter the request at or following the public hearing. The application and zoning ordinance are available for inspection at the Municipal Building Monday through Thursday 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Copies of the application may be examined at said public hearing.

The Baroda Township Planning Commission will also hold a public hearing on the same evening of Monday, October 8, 2018 to hear public opinion on amending the Baroda Zoning Ordinance Section 13. Special Land Uses adding Section 13.29 to provide for Resorts in Baroda Township, Amending Section 2-Definitions, Amending Section 9.03 Special Land Uses, Amending Section 12.03 Parking, Amending Section 13.26, 8. Bed and Breakfast, amending Section 13.28, 3a. Campgrounds. The proposed amendment and zoning ordinance are available for inspection at the Municipal Building Monday through Thursday 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed amendment may be examined at said public hearing.

Written comments will be received from any interested persons concerning the foregoing application and amendment by the Baroda Township Clerk up to the date of the hearing, and may be further received by the Planning commission at said hearing.
