

## **Minutes for the Baroda Township Budget Workshop 1/13/2022**

The Baroda Township Board met January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the Municipal Buildings Meeting room at 9091 First St., for the purpose of reviewing and working on the Proposed Budget for 2022-2023, for the Fire Maintenance Fund, Fire Equipment Fund, Water Fund, Road Fund, Ambulance Fund, Police Fund, Rubbish Fund and Building Fund.. The meeting was called at 6:02pm, Present were Board Members, Larry Klug, Dennis Krotzer, William Hurst, David Wolf and Christina Price. There was 5 Audience Members.

On the Agenda was a notice from the **State of Michigan for Eligibility as Charter Township** to be reviewed at the next regular meeting. **Ruggles Cemetery Burial Approval:** Clerk Christina Price reported that a resident would like permission to add his father's cremains to a burial plot that already has one full burial and one cremation, after further discussion David Wolf made a motion to approve the cremation burial addition as it will be Mother full burial and two brother cremains, supported by Dennis Krotzer. Vote-All Yes. Motion Carried. **Budget Workshop-** The Board Members worked on the Proposed Budget for 2022-2023 agreeing to give about a 4% increase to all the Fire Departments salaries along with increases to hourly positions. The Board was able to review Fire Maintenance Fund, Fire Equipment Fund, Water Fund, Road Fund, Ambulance Fund, Police Fund, Rubbish Fund and Building Fund. The General Fund and Water Fund will be reviewed at the next Budget Work shop on January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 6:00pm
