

Minutes for the Baroda Township Special Meeting 10/3/2022

The Baroda Township Board met October 3rd, 2022 at the Municipal Buildings Meeting room at 9091 First St., for the purpose of reviewing and working on the Rubbish Assessment Increase, MERS Contract Date change, Broad Band Update, Master Plan Survey Questions and Sewer Contract. The meeting was called at 5:50pm, Present were Board Members, Larry Klug, David Wolf, Dennis Krotzer, William Hurst, and Christina Price. No Audience members.

- Rubbish Assessment Increase – After discussion Dennis Krotzer made a motion to approve a Rubbish Increase to \$215 per assessment, seconded by David Wolf. Roll Call Vote- Voting Yes, William Hurst, David Wolf, Dennis Krotzer, Larry Klug, Christina Price. Voting No- None Motion Carried.
- MERS Contract – Christina Price mentioned that the Township would need to change the start date for the 457 and Defined Contribution plan through MERS from August 1st, 2022 to April 1st, 2022. After further discussion David Wolf Made a motion to change the start date from August 1st, 2022 to April 1st, 2022, seconded by Dennis Krotzer. Vote All Yes. Motion Carried.
- Broad Band Update – William Hurst presented paperwork identifying information that was gathered and talked about getting pricing from MEC to determine options for Township residents for Broadband coverage.
- Sewer Contract – Dennis Krotzer presented a draft sewer contract from Lake Township for the Board members to review. He also planned to have the Township Attorney review it.

Supervisor Dennis Krotzer made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:19pm, seconded by David Wolf. Vote-All Yes. Motion Carried.
